Behavioral Expectations:

Students who have earned a violation will result in not being allowed to participate in the next senior privilege.

Reminder:

The NYC Department of Education Citywide Behavioral Expectations to Support Student Learning will be utilized to determine student eligibility in all senior activities. Students that receive three checks will be ineligible to participate in senior activities. It may not be possible to provide a refund.

The following infractions are included but not limited to:

| Infraction | Example Description | Consequence |

| B06 Failing to be in one's assigned place on school premises | Example: Not present in academic class | 1 Check (per incident) |
| B08 Engaging in verbally rude or disrespectful behavior | Examples: cursing, eye rolling, or any behavior suggesting or implying disrespect to peers & school authority (all staff members) | 1 Check (per incident) |
| Teacher Detentions | | 1 Check (per every 5 days of detention) |
| Lateness | Example: Students who arrive after the start of the period | 1 Check (per every 15 lateness's) |
| Level 3/4/5 Infractions | B33- B62 | 3 Checks |



Additionally, it is the policy of the Department of Education Office of Safety and Youth Development not to exclude students from graduation for behavioral reasons, except in very limited circumstances. Students may be excluded if they pose a threat of violence or disruption to the event or if they engaged in conduct that was particularly serious or dangerous. This policy applies to students who are on suspension at the time of graduation or who otherwise engaged in misconduct prior to the graduation.
